Plasma is formed through the ionisation of atmospheric gas, which works to stimulate the contraction, shortening and tightening of skin fibres, thus resulting in the reduction of the skin surface.

It is a small device and easy to use. This technique is non invasive, painless and bloodless. There is no cutting of the tissues and that is why no stiches or sutures are used in the procedure.
