AFTER SURGICAL BLEPHAROPLASTY WITH COMPLICATIONS

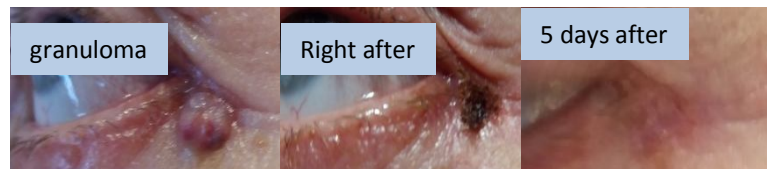


-With an ELECTRICAL ARC who creates the medical device we use, in the air, between the tissue and the tip of the device, we achieve the method of SUBLIMATION THERAPY of the targeted point of tissue we choose, with the characteristic **no diffusion of the energy to the surrounding tissue**. This makes this **treatment very precise and absolutely safe for applications on the periocular area**.

-With different techniques, we can use this method to sublimate and shrink the tissue superficial, like non surgical blepharoplasty, we can drain a pathology like a cyst, we can “cut” a pathology from its bottom like a papiloma, we can remove age spots by using it like a “paintbrush” and much more.

COMPLICATIONS after SURGICAL BLEPHAROPLASTY we treated with this method were

- 1.insufficient skin removal
- 2.resistant suture cyst(milia)
- 3.scars on the suture line
- 4.inflammatory granuloma
- 5.asymmetry that involves the skin
6. Mild hooding of upper eyelid skin on the skin closest to the temple



CONCLUSIONS

- 1.The results of our treatments with this method were excellent. Some of the complications we treated, had no other solution than surgery or using of an scalpel. With this bloodless method we avoided surgery, scalpel and new stitches.
2. **This method and this device is very useful** not only for doctors who are not surgeons, but as we show, it is a special “gadget”, with the proper handling, **also for surgeons for surgical blepharoplasty** to treat their mild or moderate complication that can appear after a surgery
